From the start of the year all the way through, I was never sure as to what I was supposed to be getting out of the lectures or discussions. Even the TA's, when questioned about the direction of his lectures, were entirely unsure. If this class had a greater focus and had a set learning outcome with regards to cities (the class topic which I felt was often strayed from), it would have been significantly more appealing.
